NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR PUBLIC INPUT INDIANA FAMILY AND SOCIAL SERVICES ADMINISTRATION (FSSA) AGED BLIND & DISABLED (ABD) STUDY COMMITTEE

House Enrolled Act 1328 requires the Indiana Family and Social Services Administration (FSSA) to prepare a report on Medicaid managed care for the blind, aged, and disabled Medicaid population for the legislative Health Finance Committee by December 15, 2013. The report is to review three approaches: risk-based capitated managed care; managed fee-for-service; and home and community based services management program.

The FSSA has formed a task force of representatives of all five FSSA divisions to develop this report. This task force is working with no preconceived notions of the outcome of this process. In the interest of receiving input from all interested stakeholders, the FSSA ABD Task Force already received input at a public meeting on July 12, 2013 and has developed and shared a survey of consumers, providers and other stakeholders.

There will be three more opportunities for stakeholders and interested parties to provide input into the process. Representatives of several interested provider and consumer groups will present presentations at two public meetings on Thursday August 15 and Friday August 16, 2013. Then on Monday August 19, 2013, an additional public meeting will provide any other members of the public with the opportunity to present brief comments to the task force.
