- Indiana Department of Health (IDOH) and the Division of Mental Health and Addiction (DMHA) collaboration
- Funded by the Garrett Lee Smith Suicide Prevention Grant
- Launched in July 2022 to assess youth-targeted public health, mental health and suicide prevention initiatives
- Led by a diverse group of young leaders ages 14-24 from all corners of Indiana
