Subject: Eligible Counties for Annual Activity License – Civic two (2) Year

Pursuant to Indiana Code § 4-32.3-4-5.5, a civic organization may apply for a two-year license to conduct casino game night activities if it is in a county where not more than three (3) qualified organizations possess an annual casino game night license. Accordingly, eligible qualified civic organizations located in the following counties, pursuant to statutory requirements, may apply:

Additional Reminders:

- The application period will be open through September 30, 2023. Thereafter, if more than one (1) otherwise qualified bona fide civic organization has applied for a two-year license in a particular

county, the Commission may hold a random drawing to determine which organization to award the license.

- Qualified civic organizations must submit the following forms to apply: Application for Annual Activity License (Form CG-AL), including Schedules A, B, and C, and Qualification Application (CG-QA) if the organization has not received notice from the Indiana Gaming Commission in the preceding three years that it has been deemed to be a qualified organization. These forms may be found at <https://www.in.gov/igc/charity-gaming/charity-gaming-forms>.
- All successful applicants are required to comply with all elements of the statute (I.C. art. 4-32.3) and statute (68 IAC 21-9), including all reporting requirements and payments of fees.
